7.2.3 Stage three

In which there is no restriction on the maximum number of places for any AM

If there are still places available, they shall be allocated one per AM to those AMs still wanting them, using the AM list described in 7.2.2 (ii). If any AM has requested places after the initial closing date, they should be added at this stage.

7.2.4 Stage four

If at any stage the maximum number of entrants is achieved, the organising authority shall notify at least the next five persons on the list 7.2.2(ii) informing them that they are a reserve should any AM reduce its places allocated in 7.2.1 to 7.2.3. If places become available immediately prior to the start of an event, the Organising Authority may make up the numbers to the entry limit, by informing the reserves and then continuing the allocation of places from the list referred to in 7.2.2 (ii).
